






Figure 20: Uses Of The Mobile Phone For A Range Of Purposes In The Last 12 Months Across Surveys






Figure 26: Use Of Websites Versus Applications On The Mobile Phone (As A Percentage Of All Respondents)

RWD Adoption Over Time




